The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Senator Watkins, Chairman. Senator Watkins introduced Hal Greer, JLARC staff Director, who provided the Commission with a brief overview of the meeting agenda. The first order of business was the Commission's approval of the Auditor of Public Accounts workplan due to a lack of a quorum at the May 12, 2014 Commission meeting. Senator Watkins recognized Martha Mavredes, APA Director, and requested a motion to approve APA's workplan. Delegate O'Bannon made a motion to approve the workplan, which was seconded by Delegate Landes and approved unanimously by the Commission.

Subsequently, Mr. Greer provided some brief comments regarding the creation of a JLARC subcommittee to meet at 9:00 a.m. on July 14 to discuss potential studies for staff to begin this year once current projects are completed. Senator Watkins appointed the following members to this subcommittee: Delegate Cox, Senator Howell, Delegate O'Bannon, Delegate Spruill, and himself.

Mr. Greer then introduced Jamie Bitz who presented a briefing of the *Low Performing Schools in Urban High Poverty Communities* report. Mr. Bitz answered several questions from the Commission throughout his presentation. At the conclusion of Mr. Bitz's presentation, Senator Watkins invited The Honorable Anne Holton, Secretary of Education, to provide the Commission with remarks in response to the JLARC study. Following Secretary Holton's remarks, Senator Watkins requested a motion to receive the report and authorize printing. A motion was made by Delegate O'Bannon, seconded by Delegate Cox, and approved unanimously by the Commission.

Mr. Greer introduced Erik Beecroft who presented a briefing of the *Size and Impact of Federal Spending in Virginia* report. Mr. Beecroft answered several questions from the Commission throughout his presentation. At the conclusion of Mr. Beecroft's presentation, Senator Watkins requested a motion to receive the report and authorize printing. A motion was made by Delegate Massie, seconded by Senator Colgan, and approved unanimously by the Commission.


