The meeting was called to order at 10:04 a.m. by Senator Watkins, Chairman. Senator Watkins then recognized Hal Greer, JLARC staff Director, who provided a brief overview of the meeting agenda. Mr. Greer then introduced Ellen Miller who presented a briefing of the *Assessing the Performance of Virginia's DMV* report. Ms. Miller answered several questions of the Commission at the end of her presentation.
