





JLARC Fiscal Impact Reviews of Executive Orders

New JLARC responsibility

- Legislation enacted during the 2016 session (§ 30-19.1:12)
- Fiscal impact reviews of executive orders issued by governor
- Conducted at request of committee chairman

Proposed policies

- Any chairman or co-chairman may request a review
- Any executive order may be subject to a review
- Focus on near-term fiscal impact to operations of state government
 - Will not address merits or legal issues

Proposed policies continued

- Fiscal impact statements
 - Emailed to requesting chairman
 - Emailed to committee chairman in both houses with jurisdiction over subject matter
 - Posted to JLARC website

Proposed procedures

- Email request to JLARC director
- Director response within three days indicating date by which statement will be issued
- Statement issued before Division of Legislative
 Services prefile request deadline, if possible

Commission discussion and vote

 Request Commission discuss and vote on proposed policies and procedures
