Journey to Multisourcing Environment

- 2005 Comprehensive Infrastructure Agreement
- 2007 Transformation largely complete
- 2015 Final Recommendations Report by VITA consultant

Recommendation	Status
The commonwealth should start now to disentangle services from the CIA	V
The commonwealth should adopt a multi-supplier model with a services integrator through a competitive bid	Dec. 15
VITA should create a Platform Relationship Office to manage the new services delivery model	V
VITA should lead the implementation of a new governance model that increases agency involvement	






Transition Summary

- Guiding principle: Ensure operational stability during transition to new suppliers
- Transition has been challenging
 - Expedited transition from Northrop Grumman necessary to implement new model
 - Initial transition from Northrop Grumman to Science
 Applications International Corp. (SAIC) on Aug. 18 a success
- MSI did not commence on Oct. 1 as planned because supplier not ready
 - MSI to execute "live implementation" with focus on supplier integration
- Financial: Business case remains intact






Timeline for Transition to New Model

Service Tower Supplier Commencement

- Dec. 15: Five suppliers will execute a "walkin, take-over" transition
 - VITA and its suppliers are working to ensure agencies will not experience delays or disruption
 - Suppliers will be fully integrated with MSI
- Early 2019: VITA will manage suppliers to begin modernization of environment
 - Ensure commonwealth agencies and citizens receive full benefit of contracted services
